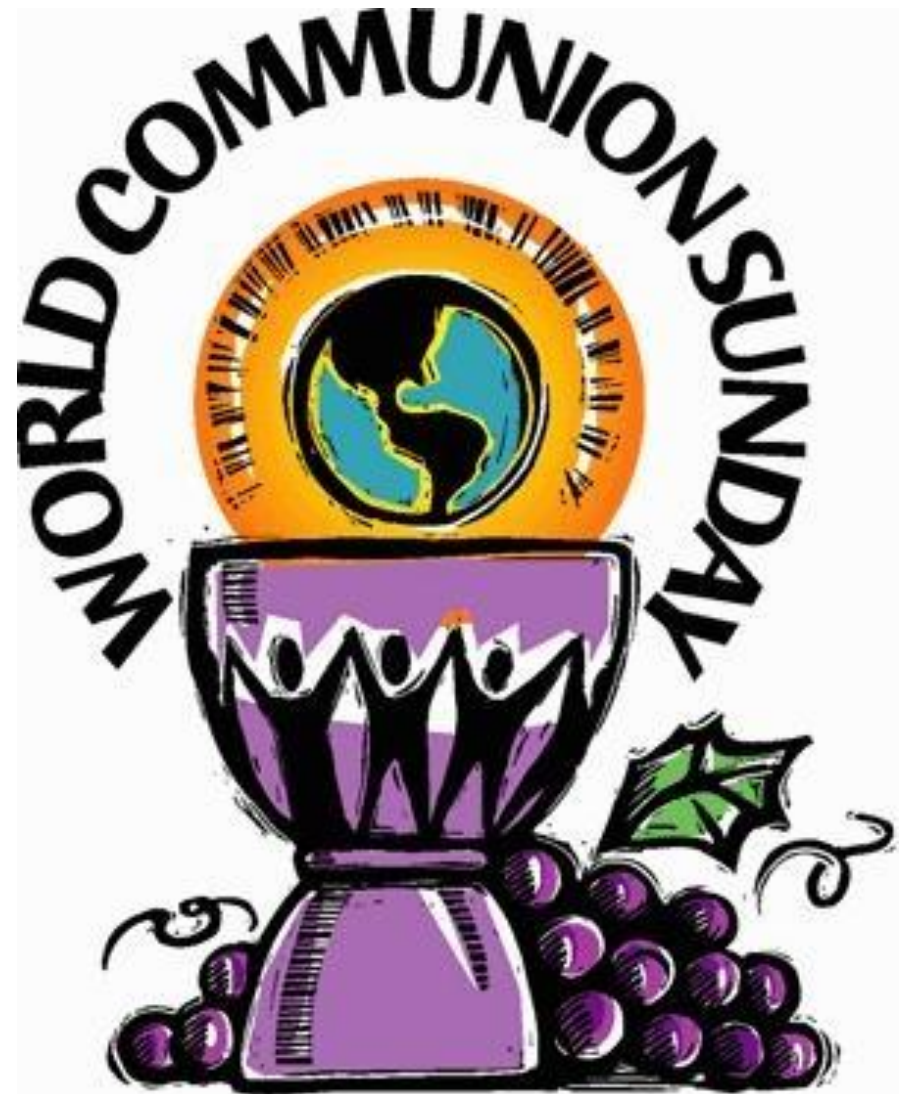
LET US REMEMBER WITH PRAYERS AND CARDS: (Week of 10-2-22)
