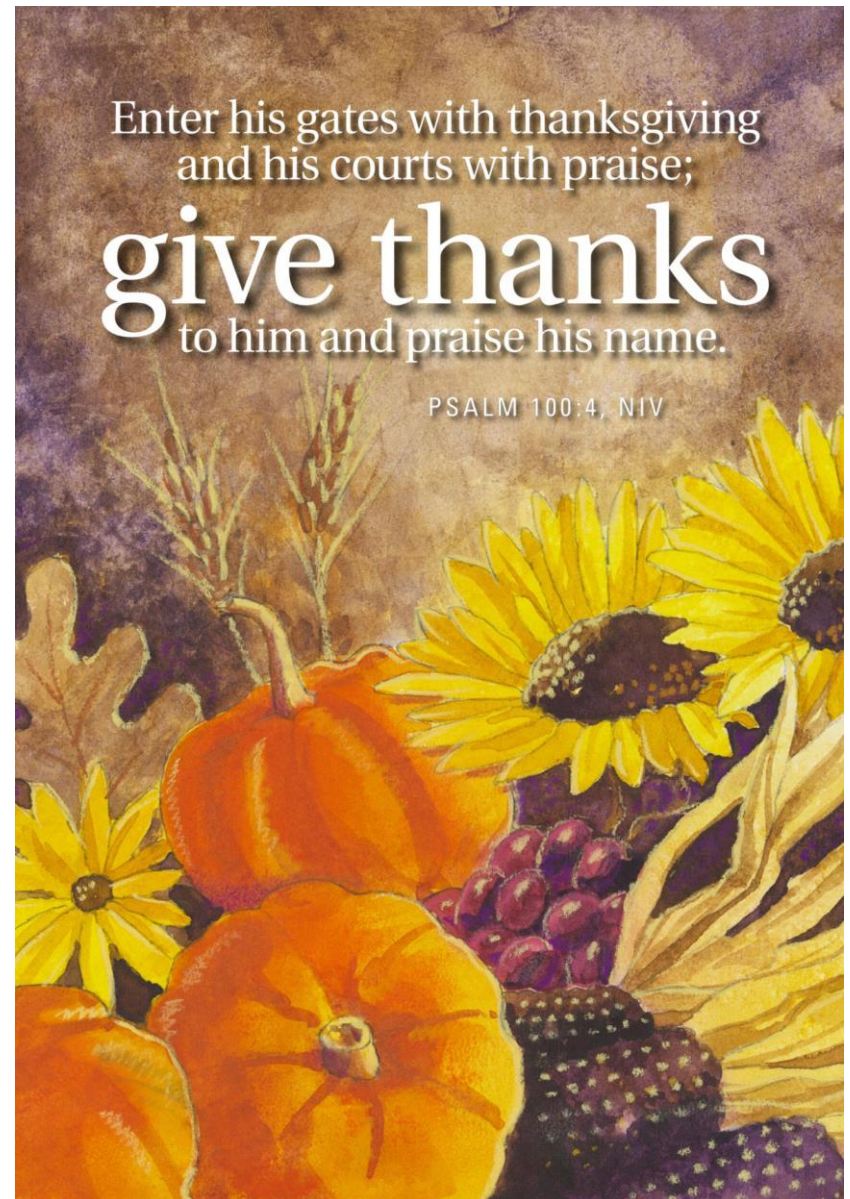
OUR DEEPEST SYMPATHY is extended to the family of Gerry Young who passed away on Tuesday, November 15, 2022.
