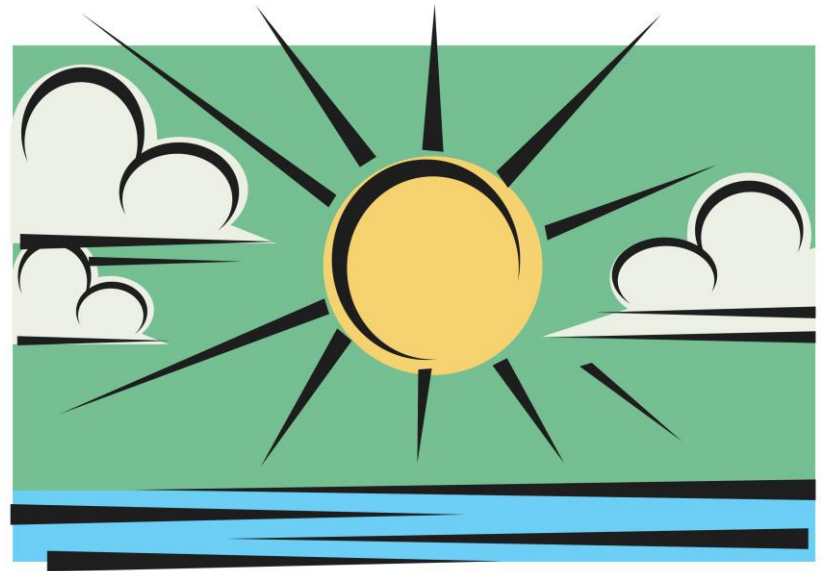

COOKIE WALK DECEMBER 10, 2022

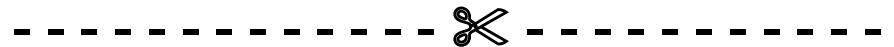
